“You just put a little mustard on it and cook for an hour at 325.” Sandra gives Michael instructions for cooking the turkey liver.



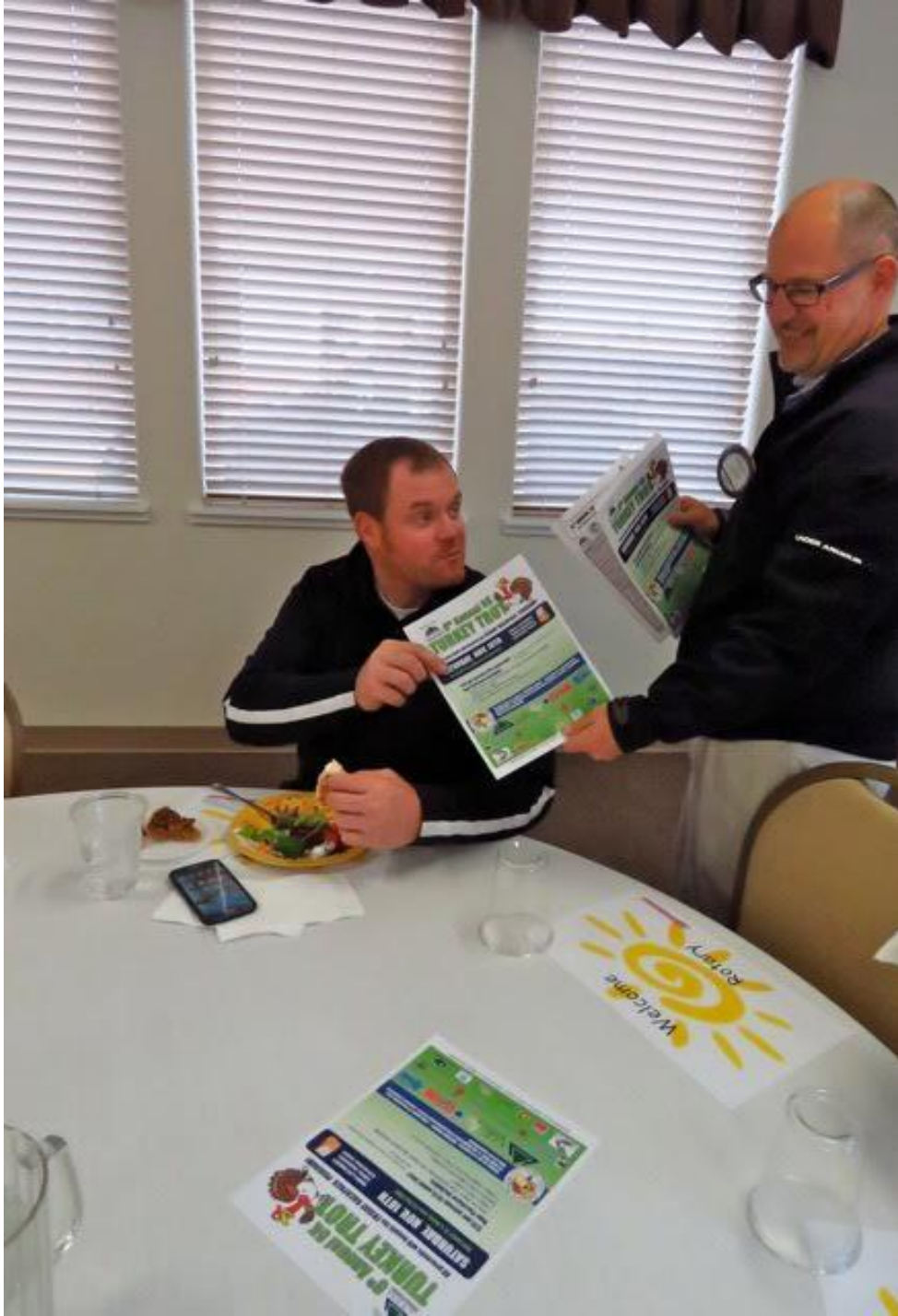
"My turkey is bigger than your turkey!" Shane and Debra have a Thanksgiving show down.
