“Does Sandra want Tucker to put some pennies in dah whittle piggie?” Tucker makes an inquiry about the Rotary Foundation.



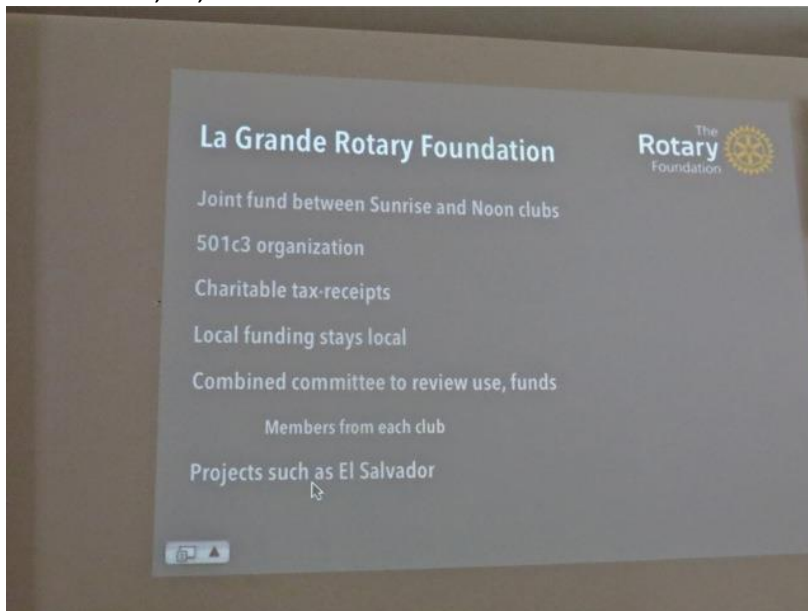
Cue music, “Wonder Woman!” Kelsie is stylin’ in her battle gear.
