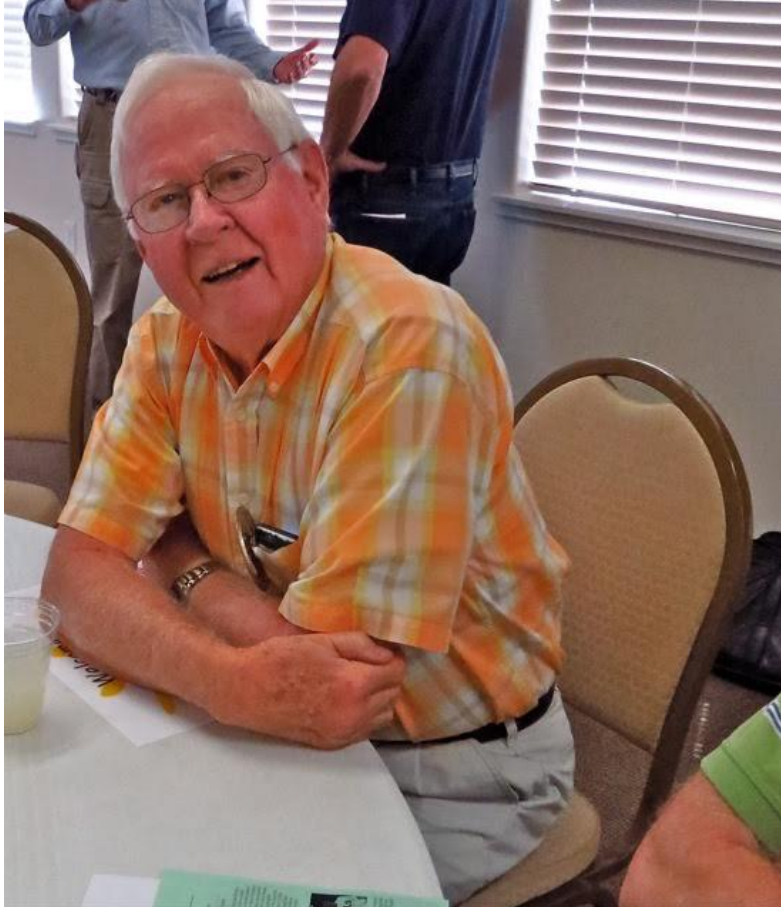


**Rotary 5-29-2018**
