

Rotary 9-11-18

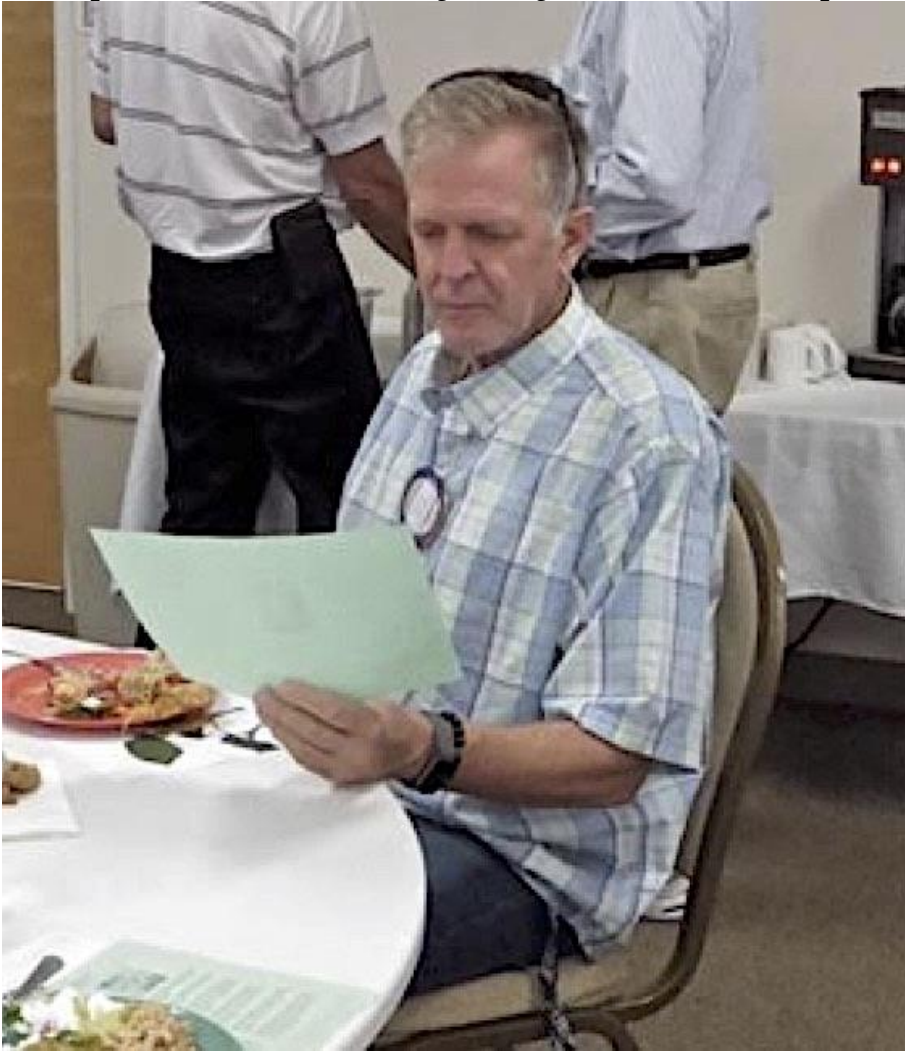
“Computer eh? Is that anything like an etch-a-sketch?” Jeff attempts to help our speaker set-up pictures for her presentation.
