“You mean there are rules I have to read about the Hokey Pokey?” Doyle questions Deb. Dale suggest that Doyle can just look at the pictures.



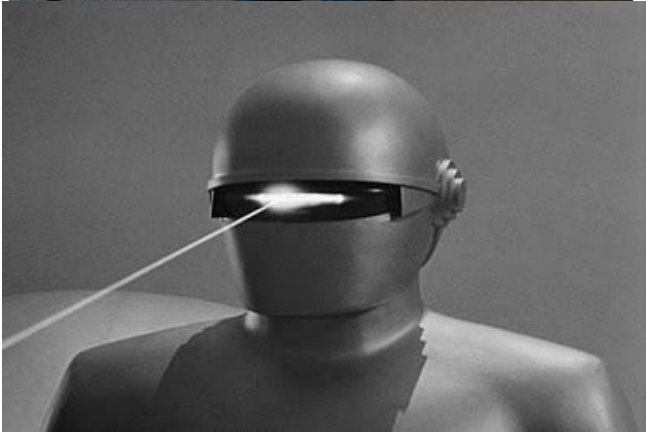
